Principal Number:

2-Black Soil Star, Trigram – K'Un, Earth – The Receptive, Mother

Trigram Symbolism Interpretation (Bagua/Element/Family Member):

The three yin lines represent the full force of earth and her maternal qualities. This trigram indicates a strong consistent nature with a desire to serve. The element soil represents earth and the family member is the mother (Mother Earth). These bring the feminine qualities of receptiveness, helpfulness, supportiveness, diplomacy and caring (when healed and coming from our positive power and not in defensive mode). Both males and females with this principal number try to provide a fair and open chance for everyone.

Personality / Nature / Star Qualities:

People with a principal number 2 (Black Soil Star) are not natural born leaders, but busily work in the background and quietly get the job done. They are steady and reliable. The quality of the number 2 soil is described as sand or compost giving the image of a nurturing helpful nature. This earthly and maternal nature is not only expressed within their family but also extends to the larger family of humanity. Non-aggressive in nature these individuals have a strong and patient quality. Due to their sociable and public-spirited qualities they make excellent social organizers or teachers. Helping others gives them great satisfaction. The number 2 soil needs to be within a group for support or they can easily lose direction and spirit. With a tendency to be over-fastidious and fussy in their working methods, they can get bogged down in details irritating those around them. Often feeling at home on the land or in the woods, gardening or walking in the country could be good forms of recreation for those with this principal number.

Health:

This group of people has a sensitive quality and do not have a strong constitution. In ancient Chinese medicine, soil controls the function of the spleen, pancreas and stomach. These central organs are the center for the lymphatic and immune system. Special attention should be focused on the care of the pancreas restricting refined carbohydrates, ice cream, dairy products, sugar, sweets and chocolate. Suggestions to aid in the process are to chew very well, eat smaller meals but more frequently during the day, include plenty of grains as well as fruit to provide natural sugar. Special attention to the immune system is also important. You should allow your body to slowly adapt to changes in climate avoiding too many long hot baths, central heating and air conditioning.

Occupations:

Positions of service to humanity and community work well for 2 Soil people. Some examples of service occupations are nursing, social worker, retail, and banks. Those with a 2 Soil principal number would also fit well in agriculture or horticulture based career.

Personal Development:

Because of the propensity for people in this group to help others, it is important for them to make time and space to re-energize themselves. They need to work on finding balance

between work and play, giving and receiving, leading and being led. In addition, take plenty of fresh air and exercise to avoid physical stagnation.

Character Number:

3 – Bright Green Tree

Character:

The number 3 Bright Green Tree character in the natural world is the quality of the full force of spring or the awakening of the dawn. These are forward thinking people, progressive in their thinking and actions. This group of individuals always enjoys initiating and discussing a new idea or project as well as suggesting a social event. When it comes to the details of these ideas, projects or events, their enthusiasm may not be as apparent. Sometimes they can take on too many things at once giving the impression of a chaotic character. They have an adventurous impulsive nature that can affect everyone around them. If they are happy, bright and fulfilled, others will feel the same, however if they are angry and frustrated, this will rub off on those around them. Due to the vanity of the number 3 Tree, any emotional or physical defeat is taken personally. Not having their own way can frustrate and anger these individuals but since the number 3 Tree is associated with the Bagua symbol of Thunder, these feelings will soon 'roll on'.

As a Child:

A child in this group is best supported by being allowed to explore his/her ideas and creative talents to the fullest. Encouragement will help to keep their interest. Their natural curiosity should not be ignored or squelched. These children like to socialize and are likely to be the last one in from the playground. These children are often precocious and take an earlier interest in the opposite sex than their peers. Their physical appearance and clothing are important to them and find it highly offensive if they are criticized. Suppression of any kind is the most damaging thing for children with this nature.

Energetic Number:

4 – Green Tree Star

The number 4 Green Tree will appear quiet, dependable, gentle and helpful. You can count on them to keep their word. With a symbolism of Wind may give the impression that you are easily influenced by events around you. Individuals in this group have the greatest tendency towards change than those in any other of the nine energetic types.

The Combination (Principal/Character/Energetic):

2-Principal / 3-Character / 4-Energetic

Your first impression to others is that you are quiet, dependable, helpful, gentle, diplomatic and consistent. You can be fastidious over detail in your work and life. Your close family and friends will see you inner nature of the 3 Tree which can be expressive and at times explosive. Like the symbolism of Thunder, this can come without warning and be something for those around you to behold.

House Number:

8 – Soil House (Stillness)

Symbolism:

The number 8 Soil House of Stillness can be an uncomfortable house. In this house there can be times of stillness and equally suddenly, radical change. Since the next house (9- Fire House-Fame) represents the full force of Fire, this house represents the calm before the storm. You can feel uneasy and unsure of what is coming next. In the Magic Square which is the center Bagua Square of the 9 year cycle, the 8 house occupies the north-east position which represents the transition from winter to spring or the time between midnight and dawn.

Interpretation:

The Trigram Ken translates to Mountain in the Bagua. This evokes the image of stillness. This can mean that most of the year will be stagnant and a time for you to retreat into your 'cave' deep within the Mountain. During this period communication can be an issue. You can easily be misunderstood and you need to express yourself more clearly than usual. Since communication goes both ways, you need to pay special attention to fully listening to others. Change is definitely in the air and decisions about change can be brought about by external pressure or internal reflection.

Recommendations:

Since your quietness and stillness while you occupy this house may be disturbing to others around you if you retreat or become stubborn, try not to be rigid or push your ideas too hard as this will cause antagonism. Make sure to give yourself plenty of time and be sincere in whatever changes you undertake. It is okay to be slow and give plenty of thought before taking action.

Big changes in your life can work well at this time as long as they are in alignment with you dream. While you are in the 8 house it is not wise to take a total reversal of direction or to enter into a completely new venture you are not familiar with.

Try to stay calm and aware of what is happening around you. If you start to retreat to your 'cave', try to force yourself to stay out and continue with development of you plans. Your rebellious spirit during this time can be misunderstood and cause unnecessary antagonism towards you so try to keep this in check.

Health:

While in the 8 house, a stagnant year, try to keep active and pay attention to your circulation and lymphatic system. Take care not to get into arguments that could lead to fights leaving you on the losing end. During this period you can be more vulnerable so take care to avoid accidents especially ones caused by others. If you have a 1 Water or 3 or 4 Tree as your principal number, avoid stagnation. The quietness and stillness of the 8 House may bring about a bigger desire for change for you in particular.
